Financial Hardship Chart

Unemployed	Full Scholarship
Income up to \$15,000	75% discount
Income \$15,000-\$35,000	50% discount
Above \$35,000	No discount

All requests are confidential. Financial Hardship requests must be received at least 30 days prior to the start date of the seminar, workshop or conference.
